A special election will be held for voters of District 5 to elect a successor to fill a vacancy for the office of councilmember. Election results will be announced after 6:00 p.m. on August 7, 2009.

- **VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE** - Wednesday, July 8, 2009
- Last day to File Financial Disclosure Statement - Friday, July 10, 2009
- Absentee Walk Voting at City Hall - Thursday, July 23 to August 5, 2009
- Last day to Request Absentee Mail Ballots - Friday, July 31, 2009
- **LAST DAY FOR BALLOTS TO BE RECEIVED (Election Ends)** - Friday, August 7, 2009

VOTE-BY-MAIL

The election will be conducted entirely as a "Vote-By-Mail" election. All registered voters as of the voter registration deadline will automatically be mailed a packet containing the Vote-By-Mail ballot and return envelopes. **No polling places will be open on August 7, 2009 (end of election).**

Ballots will be mailed approximately 20 days prior to the election. Voted ballots **must be received** by the City Clerk no later than 6:00 p.m., August 7, 2009 **in the return envelopes provided.**

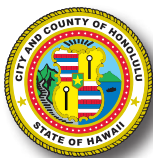
Submission of an "Absentee Ballot" application form to receive a ballot packet is not required **unless** the registered voter transfers registration (re-registers) into the district after the voter registration deadline or if the voter is unable to receive mail at the address listed in the general county registry.

WALK IN EARLY VOTING

Any voters requiring the use of an accessible voting machine may do so at Honolulu Hale between July 23, 2009 - August 5, 2009 excluding Sundays and holidays between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Walk in voting will be open on Saturdays during this period.

REMINDER

Council District 5 is located in a densely populated area. A voter may live in the district and their neighbor across the street may not. Also, being properly registered to vote with all your current information promotes timely receipt of your ballot. If there is any uncertainty in regards to your voter registration status, please call 768-3800.
